DESCRIPTION

Pegamento Pisos Vinílicos 525-23185-100 is a vinyl floor glue developed for manual application, where wide ranges of open times are needed, which allows its application in large areas, to then place the vinyl material.

USE

An adhesive for gluing vinyl floors on concrete and other surfaces. It can be used to glue different vinyl materials, such as tiles, rigid, flexible strands or rolled ones, on large areas where, in first place, adhesive is to be applied and, just then, the vinyl material will be placed and finally position the material. The application should be done with a toothed trowel (Teeth: $1/32 \text{ H} \times 1/16 \text{ W}$ and spaced 5/64 apart)

Once the adhesive has been applied over the entire area to be covered, it should be left long enough until the adhesive darkens and gets tacky, to cover with the vinyl material.

Drying time

Deje pasar 5 días después de la instalación antes de humedecer el piso.

After applying the adhesive, the time to place the vinyl material should not be more than 24 hours.

Drying time depends on environmental conditions, so temperature, drafts, ambient humidity and application film thickness have a direct effect on this adhesive open time.

Before this adhesive dries up, it can be removed with soap and water, after drying, use diluent 510-00456-900.

Wait for 5 days before moisten the floor.

Application Instructions

By its nature, this adhesive will maintain the application profile.

First, apply the adhesive with a toothed trowel (Teeth: $1/32 \text{ H} \times 1/16 \text{ W}$ and spaced 5/64 apart) and let enough time to get tacky (90 – 120 min) and then place the material, applying enough pressure so the adhesive correctly moisturizes the surface of the vinyl.

Then let it cure.

NOTICE

- ✓ Container must be kept out of reach of children, tightly closed in a ventilated place, away from sunlight or intense heat, between 20 and 30°C to avoid loss of its properties.
- It should be used before the expiration date indicated on the packaging label. After that date, all its warranties are void.
- Any change in environmental conditions at application can have a significant impact on its open time and drying time.
